



Hospital Addition Nearing Completion . . .

Work on the construction of the addition to Little Traverse Hospital is progressing according to schedule, according to hospital authorities.

The addition, of stone and brick construction, is now enclosed and work of installing window frames and walls is underway. Plastering and interior arrangement will follow.

The structure will provide forty additional patient beds to the hospital as well as enlarged laboratory and clinic facilities. It is expected that the addition will be ready for occupancy in October.

Construction of the Little Traverse Hospital was completed early in 1939 and funds for the construction of the needed wing were provided by an anonymous donor during the summer of 1941.—Review Photo-Engraving.
