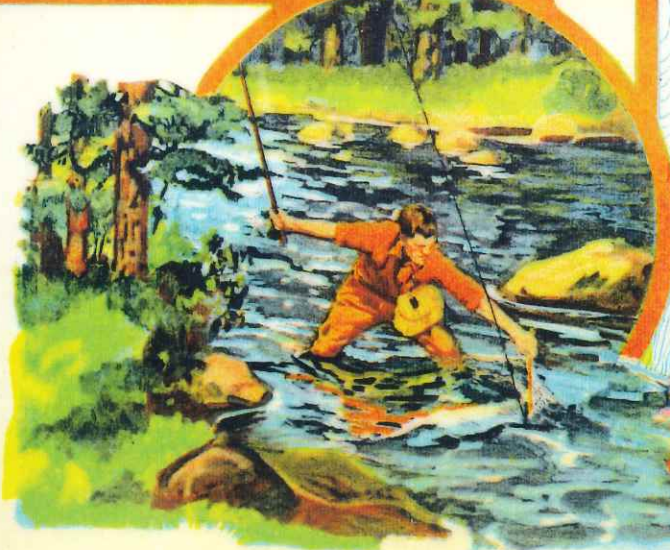
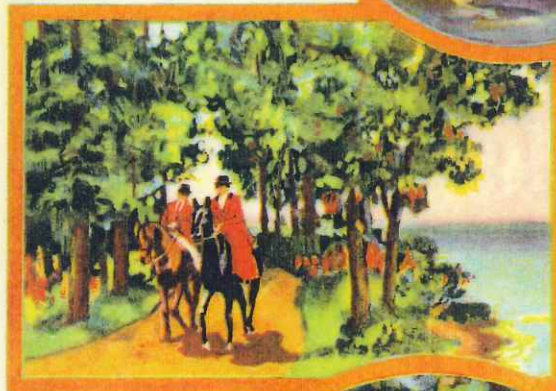
A dreamland of sparkling water, pure air, unexcelled scenery and congenial people.
