

Mr. Donat Fottig has just completed the work of removing fifty-eight bodies from the old potters' field to the new field at the south-west corner of the cemetery. The work has been carefully and faithfully done, and a record kept of all head-boards and other things that might assist hereafter in finding the graves of friends. In five of the graves the coffins were found to be remarkably heavy, and an examination indicated that the bodies had begun to petrify, for they were well preserved, while of those on both sides, buried about the same time, only the skeleton remained. The appearance also strengthens the belief that in course of time those bodies would have turned to stone.—*Ind.-Democrat.*
